McIntyre Research of Former HIPPY Students in Middle School

These scores are from the HIPPY children that were in the four-year-old program 1993-1994, 1994-1995, and 1995-1996. In 2000, the Montgomery HIPPY Advisory Board asked that the grades of any former HIPPY children attending McIntyre Middle School be obtained to see if HIPPY children maintained the early gains made by being in the program. The HIPPY Advisory Board wanted this information as 85% of McIntyre middle students were failing at least one core subject. Twenty-seven former HIPPY students were identified at McIntyre; 2 of these were in Special Ed. classes. This chart shows the composite scores of the former HIPPY students and proves that the gains are permanent.
